Just sign up at LaGrave or Kvasager and earn **50 points** before Neighborhood Networks Week (August 1). **The top 25 teams will receive their new computers on Monday, August 4.** Each time you participate in a point earning activity, let us know and we'll record them for you. You can earn points by doing the following:

Point Values

- Attend adult open computer time - 1 point/day
- Attend kids open computer time - 1 point/day
- Sign up for Camp Cook - 2 points
- Donate a book or game to LaGrave - 2 points
- Help pick up trash around learning centers - 3 points
- Read 50 pages in LaGrave/Kvasager library- 4 points
- Attend teen event - 5 points
- Help chaperone a kid/teen event - 5 points
- Attend a Resident Committee meeting - 5 points
- Vote in the June election - 10 points
- Attend *Open-Source* info. session in July - 10 points
